


Students by Disabilities


This data shows the number of students in each of the 12 IDEA disability categories. Of all the disabilities, SLD has the largest number of students with disabilities at 69%. The only disabilities with no data reported for this year are deaf-blindness and traumatic brain injury.


Students by School Level

Based on the data collected for this school year, around 94% of students with IEP are placed in regular schools. The remaining 6% are either at home, special education school, or private schools.



EXITING DATA by State

The total leavers for the FSM in school year 2017-2018 was 305_students. These graphs show the percentage of leavers for each state out of the total leavers. The FSM uses 7 out of 8 total IDEA exit categories, which are dropped out (DROP), graduated with high school diploma (GHS), moved known to be continuing (MKC), transferred to regular education (TRAN), reached maximum age (RMA), and died (D). The only category that is not applicable to the FSM is received certificate.

Students Exit by Disabilities

In 2017-2018, about 87% of the leavers were students with the Specific Learning Disability. For the six exiting categories, the one with highest number of leavers was dropped out with 37%.
