

## Scholarship Entitlements

- Return air travel
- One-off establishment allowance on arrival
- Full tuition fees
- Contribution to living expenses
- Introductory academic program
- Supplementary academic support
- Fieldwork allowance for research students and masters by coursework students which has a compulsory fieldwork component
- Overseas Student Health Cover for the duration of the scholarship



## Social Inclusions

- Applications are strongly encouraged from women, people with disability and other marginalized groups.
- For an awardee with disability, the Australian Government and the university will work together to reduce barriers to enable the awardee to live and study for the duration of the scholarship.
- The Australian Embassy will undertake an assessment of your academic and pastoral care needs of applicants and this will also be discussed with your selected institution.
- Depending on the nature of disability, assistance may include: additional academic preparation, communication software, support during lectures, tutoring support and regular support from your institution.

## How are Australia Awards candidates selected?

- Applications will be shortlisted after eligibility checking
- Only shortlisted candidates will be contacted
- The shortlisted will go through an interview
- Successful candidates will be notified no later than the end of August in the year of selection and
- Awardee travel will be subject to meeting the requirements imposed by the Australian Government, as determined by the Department of Education. Skills and employment must meet the requirements imposed by State and Territory governments.

## Two (2) types of scholarships available for FSM citizens:

**Australian Aid**

### Australia Awards Scholarship

*(for postgraduate studies in Australia)*

#### For a Master's degree:

- Must be a citizen of FSM and be residing in and applying for the Scholarship from their country of citizenship.
- Must be a minimum of 18 years of age on 1 February of the year commencing the scholarship.
- Must already have a Bachelor's degree with above average results and have at least 3 years of relevant work experience.
- Must not hold or have held a scholarship to study outside their home country in the 24 months preceding the application.
- Applicants should have an International English Language Testing System (IELTS) or Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) score at a pass rate of 6.5 for each band that is current at the time of application.
- Must not already hold a master's degree.
- Must not be a citizen of Australia, hold permanent residency in Australia or be applying for a visa to live in Australia permanently.

## Australia Awards Pacific Scholarship

*(for undergraduate and postgraduate studies in Fiji, Samoa, Papua New Guinea, or Vanuatu)*

#### **For an Undergraduate degree:**

- Must be a citizen of FSM and be residing in and applying for the Scholarship from their country of citizenship.
- Must be a minimum of 18 years of age on 1 February of the year commencing the scholarship.
- University of the South Pacific (USP) and University of Papua New Guinea (UPNG) require an associate degree with a minimum GPA of 3.0.
- Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) at Fiji National University (FNU) requires an Associate Degree in Health Careers Opportunity (HCOP) or completed tertiary education of science or health-related study program, with a minimum GPA of 3.5.
- Other undergraduate medical programs at FNU require applicants have a completed associate degree in HCOP with an minimum GPA of 3.0.

#### **For Postgraduate study program at FNU:**

- Must have completed a Bachelor's degree related to the preferred course.
- Must have at least 3 years work experience.
- Awards offered include master's study program.
