Small Island Developing States scholarships

MSc in Water and Sustainable Development at IHE Delft Institute for Water Education

Do you want to help create a better water world? Apply now for a scholarship to study for an MSc in Water and Sustainable Development at IHE Delft Institute for Water Education in the Netherlands! Citizens of Small Islands and Developing States can apply for the scholarships, offered by IHE Delft's Water and Development Partnership Programme with funding from the Dutch Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Women are particularly encouraged to apply!

The one-year MSc (68EC) is a science-based, interdisciplinary practice-oriented degree suitable for future water leaders. The two-year (120EC) Research MSc is a springboard to PhD studies or a career in research and academia. The scholarships offer full or partial funding, with priority given to those who have partial funding from other sources. Successful applicants must do their thesis research in their home country or region.

To be selected, you must:

- have secured unconditional academic admission to IHE Delft's MSc programme
- be a citizen of one of the eligible countries
- have been born in and live in one of the eligible countries
